



Polling District and Polling Places – NOTICE OF REVIEW

In accordance with Section 17 of the Electoral Administration Act 2013, the Borough Council is required to conduct a review of those parliamentary polling districts and polling places within the North West and South West Norfolk Parliamentary Constituencies.

The Acting Returning Officer is required to make representations to the Council, which must include information as to the location of polling stations within the existing and/or proposed polling places.

The Borough Council welcomes views or comments from any elector and any persons or bodies with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Comments may relate to existing polling districts and polling places or any proposed polling districts or polling places.

The Acting Returning Officer's current and new proposals for the polling districts and suitability of polling stations will be published on **Monday 16 October 2023** and will be available for inspection at the Council Offices and on the Council's website www.west-norfolk.gov.uk/PollingDistrictReview

You can also send representations via e-mail to: elections@west-norfolk.gov.uk The deadline for making representations is **Friday 24 November 2023**. The Borough Council will consider the review proposals in due course and the outcome of the review will then be published.

Final recommendations will be considered by Full Council at its meeting on **31 January 2024**. The proposals will be incorporated in the revised Register of Electors to be published on **1 March 2024**.
